<b>Tops</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Boys' and girls' short- and long-sleeved polos must be tucked in (navy blue, light blue, or white).</li> <li>❖ Short- and long-sleeved Oxford button-up shirts must be white or light blue.</li> <li>❖ Every student must have one navy blue blazer/sports coat for dress days and special events. These are available on Lands' End. Embroidery patches will be given by the academy to place on blazers after enrollment.</li> </ul>	<b>Bottoms</b>  <b>Pants/Shorts</b> <b>(Khaki only)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Girls may wear khaki pants, shorts, a skirt, a skort, a jumper, or a dress (biker shorts are recommended under skirts, dresses, and jumpers).</li> <li>❖ Boys may wear khaki shorts or pants. Boys in 3rd–5th grades must wear a brown or black belt. All boys' shirts must be tucked in (K–5th).</li> <li>❖ Elastic waist and pullup pants/shorts are available for K–2 students on Lands' End.</li> <li>❖ See colors and styles approved at our Lands' End store.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ <b>Tops should not have vendor logos.</b></li> <li>❖ <b>Shorts should be no more than 2" above the knee.</b></li> <li>❖ <b>Skirts should be no more than 1" above the knee, measured from the back of the knee.</b></li> </ul>
<b>Footwear</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Socks must be black, navy blue, gray, khaki, or white with no visible patterns. (This includes tights and leggings.)</li> <li>❖ Shoes must be mostly black, brown, navy blue, gray, or white with no distracting patterns. No Crocs (or Croc-like shoes).</li> <li>❖ No open-toed shoes.</li> <li>❖ Girls may not wear heels.</li> </ul>	<b>Accessories</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Hair accessories must be solid color, match top colors, and be removable.</li> <li>❖ Tights and leggings must be solid in color (black, gray, khaki, or white) with no patterns or lace.</li> <li>❖ Every student must wear Lands' End tie options or an identical color and pattern on dress days (see website).</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ <b>No light-up shoes or Heelys.</b></li> <li>❖ <b>No graphics or "word art."</b></li> <li>❖ <b>No bandanas or headwear.</b></li> </ul>

<b>Warm Attire for the Classroom</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ See Lands' End for options.</li> <li>❖ Hoodies with the Kairos logo or identical solid colors (navy blue, gray, or white) may be worn on designated "Spirit Wear Fridays."</li> <li>❖ Polo or Oxford must be worn under any pullover, sweatshirt, sweater, or vest. Button-up sweaters and fleeces are acceptable from Lands' End or other brands in identical styles/colors. Winter coats and rain jackets are not to be worn inside the classroom.</li> </ul>	<b>PE Wear</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Not required.</li> </ul>	
<b>Grooming</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ All students should keep their hair neatly groomed and inconspicuously styled. Hair must be kept out of the eyes so as not to interfere with eye contact and line of vision. Hair colors and patterns that do not naturally occur on people are not permitted.</li> <li>❖ Visible tattoos or markings on the body are not allowed.</li> </ul>			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ <b>Boys: Hair accessories may not be worn; mohawks, "man buns," are not acceptable. No piercings are allowed.</b></li> <li>❖ <b>Girls: No body piercing (minimal and non-distracting ear piercings are allowed) and no heavy/unusual makeup.</b></li> </ul>

- ❖ Parents can purchase Kairos-branded apparel with embroidery from the Lands' End website or find matching color and style items from other stores and/or vendors.
- ❖ All uniforms must be clean, neat, well-fitting, and in good repair.
- ❖ Students who do not follow the dress code may be required to change. It is the parents' responsibility to ensure their student complies with the KCCA dress code policy. Enforcement begins at home before the school day starts. If you are unsure about the dress code, please contact the administration.
- ❖ Any outerwear may be worn during recess; however, non-compliant outerwear must be removed in the classroom.
- ❖ Any pullover item (including sweaters) must be worn with a polo shirt or Oxford button-up underneath.
- ❖ Students must follow modesty guidelines with shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers, and dresses no shorter than 2" above the knee. Specific guidelines for different student events will be communicated ahead of time.
- ❖ **Decisions regarding the application of the dress code are at the sole discretion of the Headmaster.**
